

If you are a Health Care Provider and fall under the **Atypical** definition, you are not eligible to receive an NPI. Atypical providers are providers who do not provide medical services (ex: non-emergency transportation, case management, or environmental modifications).

The following table identifies Atypical providers as currently enrolled in Louisiana Medicaid. **These providers will continue to bill Louisiana Medicaid with the Medicaid Provider ID already assigned.**
