If you are a Health Care Provider and fall under the **Atypical** definition, you are not eligible to receive an NPI. Atypical providers are providers who do not provide medical services (ex: non-emergency transportation, case management, or environmental modifications).

The following table identifies Atypical providers as currently enrolled in Louisiana Medicaid. These providers will continue to bill Louisiana Medicaid with the Medicaid Provider ID already assigned.
