- **SUBJECT:** Reimbursement for Long Acting Reversable Contraceptives (LARCs) in the Inpatient Setting

Currently Louisiana Medicaid reimburses for 4 IUDs: J7300-Intrauterine copper contraceptive, J7301-Levonorgestrel-releasing intrauterine device, J7302-Mirena, and J7307-Etonogestrel implant. J7300 and J7302 have fees established that can be found on the DME fee schedule. Currently Louisiana Medicaid does not have an established fee for J7301 and J7307 so these claims will require manual pricing via paper claims. In the fall, the Department hopes to be able to establish a fee and have this reflected on the DME fee schedule.
