CHAPTER 27: INDEPENDENT LABORATORIES

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PROVIDER REQUIREMENTS

To enroll in Louisiana Medicaid, independent laboratories must:

- 1. Be licensed and certified by the appropriate licensing agency;
- 2. Adhere to all state and federal laws and regulations; and
- 3. Meet Medicare/Medicaid participation requirements.

Independent laboratories must also be certified under the Clinical Laboratory Improvements Act (CLIA). Independent Laboratories are limited to billing the laboratory services that they are CLIA-certified to perform. Independent laboratories must notify the Medicaid fiscal intermediary of any changes in their CLIA certification status and the test specialties they have been certified to perform. Providers must meet the following requirements, as well as any other requirements specified by the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH):

- 1. Adhere to the conditions of participation outlined in their provider agreements;
- 2. Maintain and retain business and professional records sufficient to document fully and accurately the nature, scope, and details of the health care provided; and
- 3. Provide all necessary accommodations to meet the needs of persons with semiambulatory disabilities, sight, and hearing disabilities.
