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**CHAPTER 10: MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION**

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**NEMT OVERVIEW**

Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT) is transportation provided to Medicaid beneficiaries to and/or from a Medicaid provider for a Medicaid covered service when no other means of transportation are available. NEMT does not include transportation provided on an emergency basis, such as trips to emergency departments in life threatening situations. Non-emergency ambulance transportation (NEAT) is a form of NEMT. See the Ambulance section of this manual for guidelines specific to NEAT. Services shall be provided in accordance with the Louisiana Administrative Code, Title 50, Part XXVII, Chapter 5.
