

ATTENTION ALL LOUISIANA MEDICAID PROVIDERS
ICD-10 – Is your system ready?

With the move to ICD-10, we anticipate the **most common** critical errors providers may experience to be:

- **The Date of Service** – ICD-10 is for dates of service on or after 10/1/2015.
- **837 Qualifier Codes** - Diagnosis and procedure codes must be changed from:
 - “BK to ABK” or “BF to ABF” for diagnosis codes
 - “BR to BBR” or “BQ to BBQ” for procedure codes*This is **not** a complete list of qualifier codes
- **Pharmacy Qualifier Codes** - Correct indicators are:
 - ICD-10 codes must have an indicator of “02”
 - ICD-9 codes must have an indicator of “01”
