



Attention Providers-- Affordable Care Act Mandates

Louisiana Medicaid and Molina wish to advise providers of two new web applications that are now available to Medicaid providers. These two new applications are listed in the menu of the Provider Applications Area on the secure portal of the lamedicaid.com web site. Providers must be currently enrolled and in an active 'pay-to' status for these menu items to appear. After completion of Provider Login, the new items are:

- **EFT Authorization** (EFT = electronic funds transfer)
- Electronic Remit 835

EFT Authorization – Providers may submit changes to current EFT specifications using the web application. Instructions for completion of the data fields are available under the User Manual link within the application. Once the application is completed and submitted, Molina Provider Enrollment Unit staff will review and process the request. Providers <u>should not</u> utilize this application if they do not wish to make any changes. Providers may also continue to use the hardcopy EFT request form which is available on lamedicaid.com under the Provider Enrollment link.

Electronic Remit 835 – Providers may send in enrollment request/changes for selection of a submitter to retrieve the v5010 835 remit transaction. All submitters must be enrolled and have a current 7 digit Louisiana Medicaid Submitter number assigned. Once the application is completed and submitted, the Molina Provider and EDI Department staff will review and process the request. Providers <u>should not</u> utilize this application if they do not wish to make any changes. Providers may also continue to use the hardcopy 835 request form which is available on lamedicaid.com under the Provider Enrollment link.
